This Cookie Policy explains how **SELLAI LLC** ("SafeLaw," "we") uses cookies and similar technologies on safelaw.ai and related applications (the "Service").

This Policy is part of our Privacy Policy (safelaw.ai/privacy) and should be read together with it.

1. What Are Cookies

Cookies are small text files stored on your device (computer, smartphone, tablet) when you visit a website. They allow the site to remember your actions and preferences (language, font size, authentication) over a period of time. The term "cookies" in this Policy includes similar technologies: localStorage, sessionStorage, and other browser storage mechanisms.

2. Cookies We Use

2.1 Strictly Necessary Cookies

Required for the Service to function. Cannot be disabled.

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2.3 Analytics Cookies

We currently **do not use** third-party analytics services. If we add analytics cookies in the future (such as Plausible Analytics, Microsoft Clarity, or similar privacy-focused tools), we will update this Policy and notify you before they are activated.

2.4 Marketing Cookies

SafeLaw currently **does not use** marketing cookies and does not display advertising. If this changes, we will update this Policy and request your separate consent.

3. Third-Party Cookies

3.1 Payment Providers

When you make a payment via Uzcard or Humo, the payment provider may set its own cookies on the payment page for transaction processing and security. These cookies are governed by the payment provider's privacy policy.

3.2 Hosting and Network Infrastructure

Our hosting provider and network infrastructure services may set technical cookies for security, DDoS protection, and load balancing. These are strictly technical and are not used for user tracking.

4. How to Manage Cookies

4.1 Via Our Consent Banner

On your first visit to SafeLaw, you will see a cookie consent banner where you can: accept all cookies, accept only necessary cookies, or customize your preferences. You can change your choice at any time via the cookie settings link in the site footer.

4.2 Via Browser Settings

Most browsers allow you to view, delete, and block cookies. Instructions vary by browser:

- **Chrome:** Settings → Privacy and Security → Cookies
- **Firefox:** Settings → Privacy & Security → Cookies and Site Data
- **Safari:** Preferences → Privacy → Manage Website Data
- **Edge:** Settings → Cookies and Site Permissions

Note: Blocking strictly necessary cookies may prevent some Service features from working (e.g., login).

4.3 On Mobile Devices

Cookie management on smartphones and tablets is done through the mobile browser settings.

5. Local Storage

SafeLaw may use browser local storage for: interface state, draft queries (to prevent losing typed text on accidental page refresh), and technical data for proper app operation. Local storage data is not automatically sent to our servers and is stored only on your device.

6. How Cookie Data Is Processed

Data collected through cookies is processed in accordance with our Privacy Policy (safelaw.ai/privacy) and the Law of the Republic of Uzbekistan "On Personal Data" (ZRU-547).

We do **not** use cookies to: sell your data, create advertising profiles, track your activity on other sites, or share data with ad networks.
